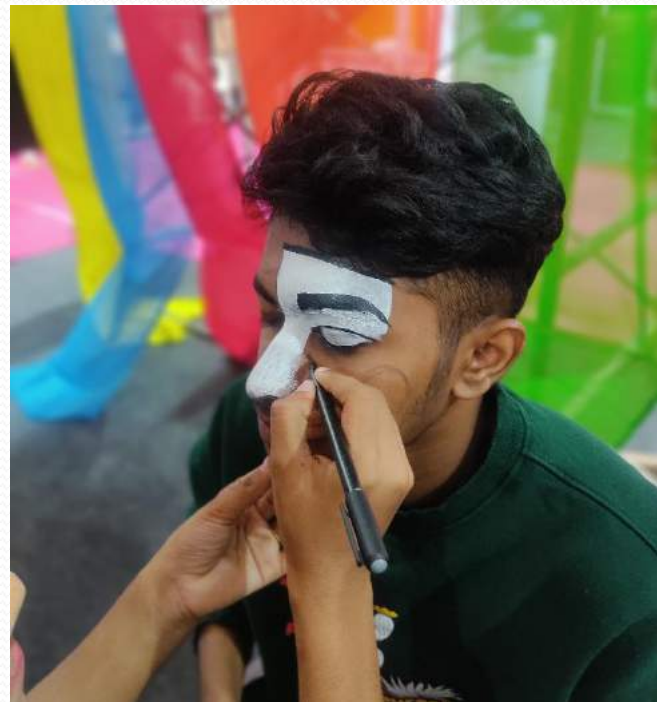
IDAM



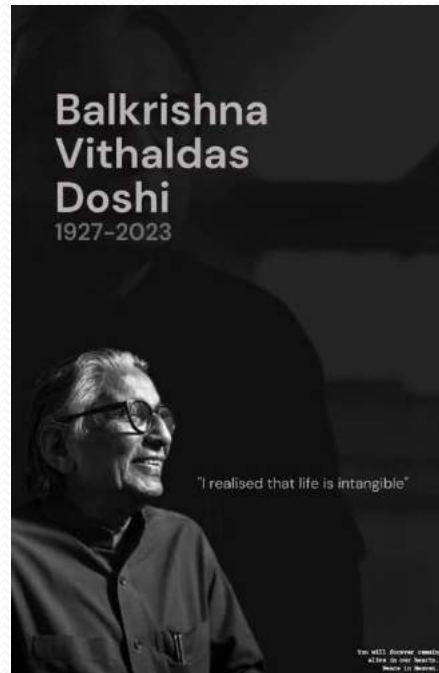
FOOTBALL MATCH

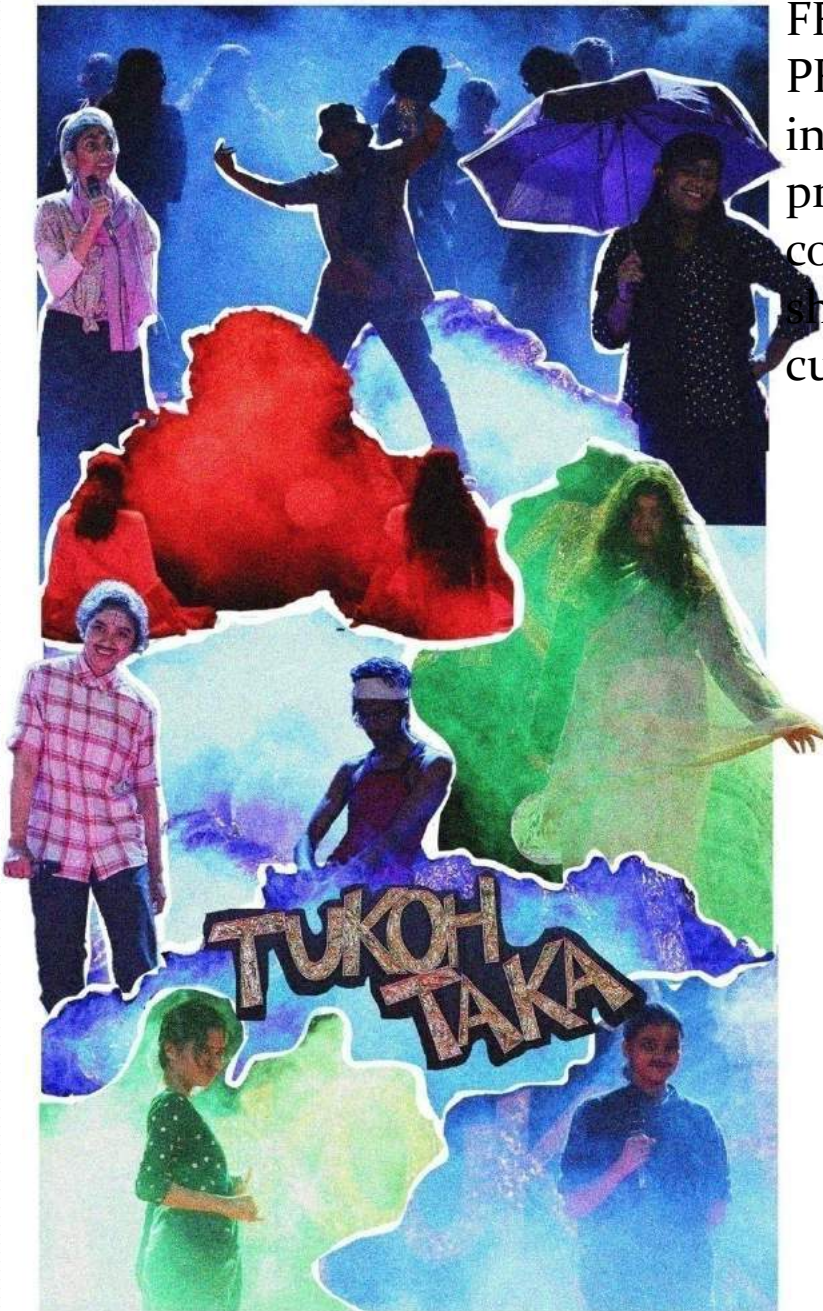
B V DOSHI (Day of demise)

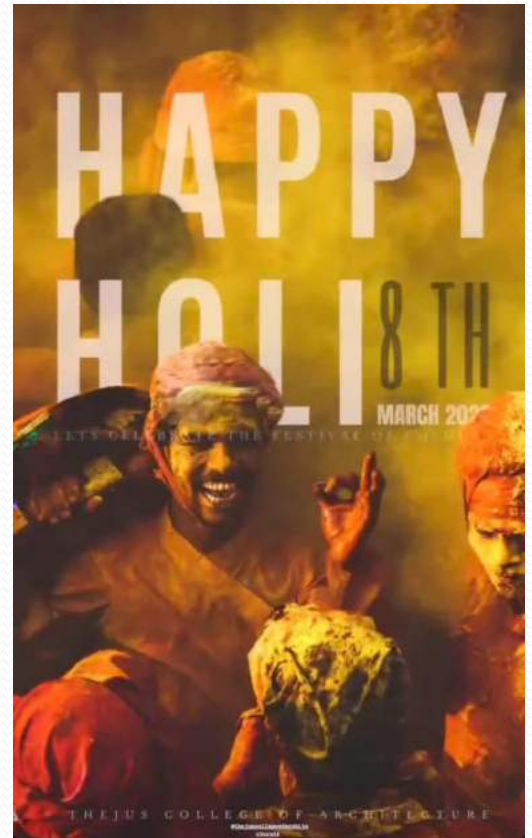
FRESHERS DAY PROGRAMME Freshers introduction and cultural programmes were conducted with fashion show, dance and other cultural events.



HOLI CELEBRATION

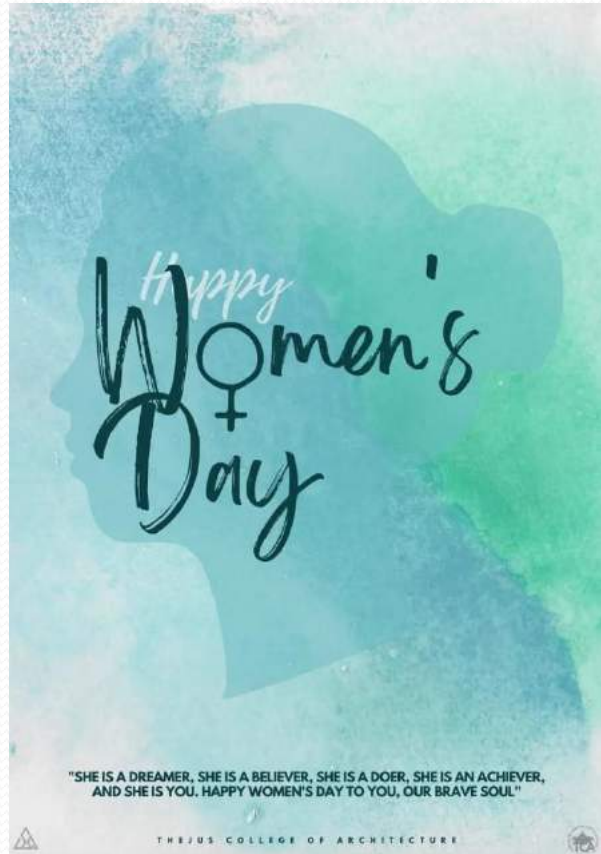
